

NORTHWEST COUNCIL OF CAMERA CLUBS
NWCCC SERVICE AWARDS
(For Individuals)

Eligibility:

An individual member of a member-club of the Northwest Council of Camera Clubs (NWCCC) may be nominated for a NWCCC Service Award for individuals:

HALL OF FAME AWARD:

The Hall of Fame Award may be awarded to an active board member, or to a formerly active board member, of the NWCCC Board of Directors who demonstrates exemplary service to the Council in his/her volunteer position on the Board. Any Board member may nominate a "Qualified" board member. (Qualified at time of service per Section. 2, Article. IV, Bylaws NWCCC)

One individual may be chosen to receive the award in any one NWCCC fiscal year. If, in the opinion of the NWCCC Awards Committee, no nominee is eligible for the award, the award shall not be given.

A member of the Board of Directors, or a former member of the Board of Directors, may be nominated for a second NWCCC Hall of Fame Award after a period of ten (10) years has passed since the individual's award of the NWCCC Hall of Fame Award.

PROGRESS AWARD:

The Progress Award may be awarded to a member of a Camera Club that is currently an active member of the NWCCC. The award shall be for service to the camera club, to the NWCCC and to the advancement of the art and science of photography.

The NWCCC Progress Award may not be awarded for service to any other photographic organization.

Any NWCCC member camera club may submit one nomination in any one NWCCC fiscal year for the PROGRESS Award. In the event that more than one person participated in the same service as a team, one Service Award may be presented for that team effort. If in the opinion of the NWCCC Awards Committee, no nominee is eligible for the award, the award shall not be given.

The nomination must be signed by the Camera Club President or by the Camera Club Secretary.

An individual may be nominated for an additional NWCCC Progress Award after a period of ten (10) years has elapsed since the individual's latest award of the NWCCC Progress Award.

PROCESS:

Nominations are effective for the current NWCCC Fiscal Year. However, nominations may be re-submitted yearly until the individual receives the award for which nominated.

A nomination for these annual service awards shall consist of not more than one typewritten page relating the qualifications of the individual.

The nomination must be **received** by the NWCCC Director of Awards by October 1. (Address on page 2 of the Newsletter of the NWCCC).

Nominations received after the deadline will be returned to the nominator, by the NWCCC Director of Awards.

REPORTS:

The Chairman of the NWCCC Awards Committee, upon arriving at a committee decision, shall prepare a report on committee findings. The report along with all files of nominations and committee minutes shall be given to the NWCCC Director of Awards for NWCCC archives.

The report must be filed with the NWCCC Director of Awards no later than October 15.

Following the presentation of awards, the NWCCC Director must acknowledge all nominations in writing, commending the participant for the nomination and recommending that another nomination be made during the following year.

AUTHENICATION

All previously approved policies concerning NWCCC Service Award are rescinded.

This NWCCC Service Awards Policy was approved by the NWCCC Board of Directors at their regular meeting on May 12, 1995.
